Business arising:

- 1. The company reported:
 - a. The mining lease has been granted and the security deposit paid;
 - b. Management plans have been approved;
 - c. Construction of bunds will commence in March/April 2019;
 - d. 30 trees have been planted to replace three removed.
- 2. Clive West produced a letter dated 4 October 2018 from the Bowral Residents Association to Wingecarribee Shire Council.
- 3. The Chairman is to write to Adam Dickson requesting advice as to whether he wishes to remain on the CCC and requesting a response within seven days.
- 4. Clive West reported that he had approached an aboriginal lady about joining the CCC and was awaiting a reply.

- d. EPA site visit (12th of October 2018) EPA had no issues very happy with site;
- e. ESU site visit in September (Craig Campbell and Greg Kinnamonth) very impressed with site knowledge and level of detail;
- f. Weather station serviced and calibrated;
- g. Section 138 for the slow down lane has been approved by Council awaiting final quotes for construction;
- h. Management plans updated and approved available online.
